KPMG in the UK named „Best Big Company to Work For” by The Sunday Times

KPMG in Hungary also recognized in the AIESEC Most Desired Company survey

KPMG in the UK wins Sunday Times „Best Big Company To Work For” award for the second time in three years. KPMG topped the ‘Best Big Company’ category for organizations with more than 5,000 employees. It is the second time that KPMG has won the award, and the fourth year in a row that it has come in the top three.

The Sunday Times Best Companies awards are the biggest survey of workplace opinion in the UK, and this year encompassed 868 organizations in total, capturing the views of over 180,000 employees. Companies are divided by size into three categories: small (those with between 50 and 249 employees), mid-sized (250 to 4,999 employees) and big companies (those with more than 5,000 staff).

In Hungary, KPMG has also done well at the Most Desired Company survey (with nearly 2,000 students asked on 170 companies) by student organization AIESEC, jointly with BellResearch and Hewitt Humán Tanácsadó.

When asked to name their dream workplace spontaneously, students mentioned KPMG in Hungary second only to OTP, the same position as in last year’s similar survey.

Overall, when students were to choose the most attractive firm from a list of 170 companies, the most desirable employers for new graduates in Hungary were L’Oreal, Nokia and Coca-Cola. KPMG came in 18th in that list.

Graduates named brand, friendly working environment, career and training opportunities and starting salary as their most important selection factors.
